

Located in Historic Deerfield, Hyde House is a newly renovated saltbox constructed almost 100 years ago with ancient posts, beams, floors and brick rescued from homes in Prescott, Massachusetts, during the Quabbin Reservoir project in the 1930s. The house was built by Herman S. Hyde and his wife Sally Burrill Hyde. As you enter our front door, the warmth of its embrace welcomes you.

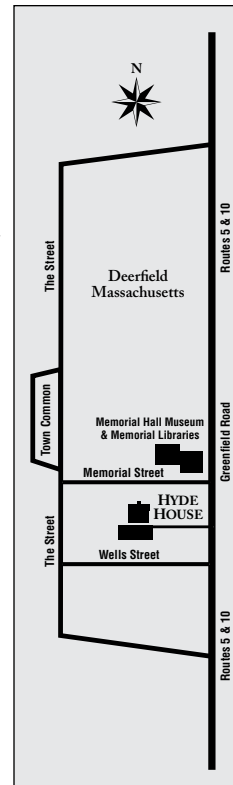
While the educational, cultural, and historical offerings are the major attraction of this area, so is the beauty of the Pioneer Valley nestled in the foothills of the Berkshires. Wander down the lane and walk to the tree canopied "Street" to visit the museums, or to attend Deerfield Academy and Eaglebrook events and graduations. Visit Memorial Hall, home of the famous "door" preserved from the attack on Deerfield in 1704. Come to our Craft Fairs, go antiquing, or shop at the flagship store of Yankee Candle. Take in the vibrancy of Autumnal colors as you drive the Mohawk Trail for its panoramic views and quaint surrounding towns.

## DIRECTIONS

### By Car:

From I-91 take exit 24 if going north or exit 25 if going south onto Routes 5 & 10.

Hyde House is just off Routes 5 & 10 North (Greenfield Road). Take a left into our drive, just before you come to Memorial Street and the Memorial Hall Museum and Memorial Libraries. Hyde House is a tan house with red shutters at the end of the drive.



Deerfield Village is just 3.5 hours from New York City and 2 hours from Boston and Albany by car.

Bradley international Airport is 55 minutes south. Car service is available at the airport.

### Sally Dolph

Located on the second floor of the original house, Sally Dolph is a lovely room with queen size bed and small sitting area decorated in soothing shades of Wedgewood blue and yellow. A TV is provided in the room. Large newly tiled private bath is a few steps away.

### Matilda

Also located on the second floor of the original house, Matilda is a beautiful Victorian bedroom with twin beds that may be converted to a king. Lovely rose florals, burgundy and green decorate the room. Large newly tiled private bath is a few steps away.
